



CODE OF CONDUCT

Basic Criteria for Fair Play Jorkyball Football 2x2 spirit

1. Jorkyball is an amateur sport at all levels based on the passion of the athletes and on the respect of the basic principle of this discipline, the *Fair Play*: a natural state of mind that contributes to making *the entire Jorkyball Family a true Fair Play model*
2. The Athlete agrees to participate in the JIF International Competitions in full respect of the opponents, the Refereeing Direction, the spectators, the local organization, the JIF Competition Director and his staff
3. Sharing values of sports loyalty and friendship is the foundation of Jorkyball and is a priority over the legitimate desire to compete and win. At the same time, JIF is committed to maintaining optimal conditions so that all athletes can compete and meet their sporting ambitions
4. JIF supports the enthusiasm of the athletes on the bench and the public for active participation in the matches and for a healthy "support" of their team. At the same time, JIF reserves the right to stop any event "against" opponents, as this behavior is not considered appropriate and consistent with the *Fair Play* spirit of Jorkyball
5. The *Fair Play* spirit of Jorkyball is not respected by warning of the obligation to return the ball when a referee grants a penalty in favor. The athlete who has suffered a foul is perfectly entitled to kick the penalty or the free-kick. *Fair Play* is more about the attitude on the field and outside, with respect for others, shaking hands with the opponent, accepting the choices of the referee and in all actions of sharing and friendships that may occur during the course of a match and the entire JIF Event

MEASURES TO ENCOURAGE COMPLIANCE WITH THE BASIC CRITERIA OF JORKYBALL FOOTBALL 2x2 FAIR PLAY

The following items are added to the current International Jorkyball Regulations and the specific rules of the Jorkyball International Federation competitions:

1. **Equal sanctions for inappropriate behavior on Social Networks / Field.** Inappropriate and disrespectful language and attitude towards the opponents, refereeing leadership, spectators, local organization and the Director of Competitions and Staff, is considered inappropriate both on the JIF Event fields, and both outside the Complex, with special reference to Social Networks and e-mail communications.
This article therefore assimilates the intention committed in person to that committed online, throughout the annual sports season. This behavior may be sanctioned by the disqualification of the athlete and JIF may reserve the right to accept or not the participation of the athlete in JIF tournaments.
2. **Prohibition of celebrating a goal against the face of the opponent (whether on the field or on the bench).** This act is considered unsporting and is punishable with a Yellow Card against the offender. This prohibition is extended in cases where a goal has been deliberately celebrated against the public supporting the opposing team.
3. **Creation of the Green Card named "warning".** The "Warning" Green Card is established. This Card is a warning to the athlete who behaves improperly or commits the same offense several times. Once the Green Card is shown, the opposing Team starts again the match by kicking from defense line. The athlete who receives the Green Card twice will be automatically notified by the referee with a Yellow Card. Finally, a Red Card / Disqualification automatically means that you can not be voted Best Tournament Player; and yellow / green cards seriously **jeopardize this application**
4. **Prohibition of bringing alcoholic beverages on the field and on the bench.** This ban applies to all players, coaches and managers of teams playing a match
5. **Principle of maximum commitment in the conduct of a match.** Each athlete is required to compete with the highest level of commitment, in order to win each match while respecting the *Fair Play* spirit of Jorkyball. If the referee, field manager or Competition Director detects an athlete's unsportsmanlike behavior, purposely to lose a set / a match for specific calculations or to save energy, the athlete and the offending team will be sanctioned of n. 1 goal assigned to the opposing team in the 1st and 2nd Set of the next match of the same Tournament
6. **Relationship Rules with Referees.** It is forbidden for athletes to speak to the referee, who expresses his choices according to the rules of the game and sanctioning, if necessary, a penalty, a free-kick or a new start from the defense line. The referee is not obliged to explain the reason for a choice and the athlete is obliged to accept the choices of the referee. The captain of the team can politely ask for explanations outside the field (during the time-out or change of Set)
